WINTER/SPRING 2012 DARTING SEASON INFORMATION

- ❖ **THE HOME TEAM CAPTAIN** should **call in the score** (978-250-8322) of each weekly match (email results will also be accepted). The Home Team Captain should also **mail in the results** of each home match (using the envelopes provided in each captain's kit) as soon as possible following the completion of each match (mailed reports are needed to verify telephone scores and compute Individual Notables).
- ❖ During the season, complete match results will be posted weekly on the league website at www.greaterlowelldartleague.com as soon as possible following the called-in scores. Also, results will be emailed to all captains who have submitted a valid email address on their team registration form. The complete results, including weekly individual notables, can be found on the league website as soon as mailed reports have been received and processed at the league office. An end of season a postal mailing will be made to all captains after Week #10 is completed (no printed results will be mailed except for Week #10). This mailing will include final standings and playoff bracket information along with playoff match report forms.
- ❖ All **ROSTER CHANGES** (even those phoned in earlier) **must be IN WRITING** and **MAILED** to the league office at:

- ❖ All matches should begin by 7:45 pm. In the event a team is late arriving for their match, a grace period of 15 minutes (or longer, if necessary) may be allowed in order that the match is played that night. Teams that might be late for a match should contact the home pub/club to notify them of any delay.
- ❖ The playing lineup must be completed by both Team Captains prior to the beginning of the match and must be made out **BLIND**. The Home captain should fill out the lineup first and insure that all information at the top of the match report is completed as well (week number, division, date, team names).
- ❖ **In the event of inclement weather** on a scheduled match night, information will be made available on the league website, through email and on the league telephone (answering machine) advising captains as to the status of league play. If scheduled matches have to be cancelled due to weather, those matches will be played the following week with the schedule being adjusted accordingly. (Example: if match play for Week #3 is cancelled, those Week #3 matches will be played the following week with all remaining matches moved up one week.
