Summer League Rules

ROSTER:

Each roster must contain a minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6 players.

Each roster must be accompanied with the registration fee of \$150 per team for the Summer Season. (Checks made payable to: Greater Lowell Dart League)

Note: During Summer League competition, a team may play a match with as few as 2 players. However, the shorthanded team must lose a turn or forfeit the point for the spots in the match with no player listed.

START TIME:

Match reports should be filled out by both captains by 7:30 p.m. The match should start no later than 7:45 p.m. A grace period of 15 minutes may be allowed by either captain in the event of some difficulty encountered by either team.

MATCH PROFILE:

Summer League match play consists of **7 total points**.

GAMES:

- 1 game of 701 -- 4-person teams - STRAIGHT START/DOUBLE FINISH
- 2 games of Cricket -- 2-person teams
- 4 games of 301 (best of 3 singles) -- DOUBLE START/DOUBLE FINISH

The **VISITING TEAM** shoots first in 701, game 1 of Cricket and games 1 and 3 of 301 singles. The **HOME TEAM** shoots first in game 2 of Cricket and games 2 and 4 of 301 singles. All other rules of play for the Fall & Spring seasons will apply. Consult your rule book.

MATCH REPORTS:

The **Home Captain** should fill in the names of both teams, the division and date at the top of the match report prior to filling in the evening's match lineup. At the conclusion of the match, the **Home Captain should CALL IN THE RESULTS (978-250-8322) and then mail the Match Report** to the league office immediately after the match.

NOTE: There are **NO PLAYOFFS** during the Summer season. Each subdivision champion will be decided by the total number of points at the end of Week #10 (in the event of ties, rules regarding tie-breakers as shown in the rule book will be observed. Individual statistics for regular Tons and RO's in Cricket are not kept during the Summer season.

Record only the following statistics for trophy consideration:

Hi On, Hi Out, 180's, RO 9's, RO 6 Cork, Low Dart Games (6, 7, 8, 9, 10) in singles.
